AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN.

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed by Relen M. Bramlett and J. A. Bramlett secured by mortgage given by Helen M. whereas, Helen M. Bramlett is still the owner of the premises covered by the above mentioned mortgage, and

WHEREAS, the said Helen M. Bramlett has requested that Liberty Life Insurance Company extend the time of payment of said note as hereinafter provided, which said Liberty Life Insurance Company has consented and agreed to do,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, we, Helen M. Bramlett and J. A. Bramlett, do hereby agree to pay to Liberty Life. Insurance Company the sum of Seventy-eight hundred (07,000.00) Dollars, that being the balance due on the note above mentioned with interest thereon from September 10, 1949 until the maturity of maid note at the rate of four and one-half (4%) per cent per mnown, said principal and interest to be paid in monthly installances as a follows:

Beginning on the 10th day of october, 1949, and on the 10th day of each month of each year thereafter the sam of \$69.67, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 10th day of Adjust, 1964, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 10th day of September, 1964; the approach monthly payments of \$59.67 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of four and one-half (4½) per centual per annum on the principal sum of \$7,800.00, or so much thereoff as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid, and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.
