Mownship, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 131 and 132 of the property of Conestee Mills according to a plat thereof prepared by R. E. Dalton in December, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 276, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Second avenue with Third street, and running thence along the Northwest side of Third street, N. 42-11 E. 180 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot Po. 133 thence along that lot, N. 47-49 W. 175 feet to a pin; thence S. 42-11 W. 177 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Second avenue; thence along the Northeast side of Second avenue, S. 46-52 E. 175 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixture now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are here by expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
