BEGINNING at an iron pin, the southeast corner of the certain property which was conveyed by Julian Calhoun to Ruth Kuhn Wick by deed dated the 27th day of July, 1949, recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C. in Book 387 at page 295, said pin being located in the center line of the Hearthstone Ridge Road and being also located South 78 deg. 16 min.
