in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ...Greenville.,.and.in.Butlar..... Township, School District 7-G, containing 64 acres, more or less, and having, according to a survey and plat thereof made Feb. 14, 1929, by C. M. Furman, Jr., Surveyor, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a stake on Rocky Branch, at the corner of lands of Cox, and lands formerly belonging to J. W. Norwood, and running thence N. 24-40 W. 26.85 chains to a stake; thence N. 74-45 E. 17.70 chains to a stake; thence N. 52 E. 5.25 chains to a stake; thence S. 25-20 E. 23.60 chains to a stake in Rocky Branch; thence with Rocky Branch in a southerly direction approximately 13 chains to a bend in Branch; thence continuing with said branch in a northwesterly direction approximately 15 chains to the beginning corner, and being bounded by the lands of J.
