NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

City of Greenville, at the intersection of the North side of Pacific Avenue with the West side of Phoenix Avenue and being shown as Lot 320 on plat of Pleasant Valley, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1946, as revised through September 1950, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at page 114, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Pacific Avenue joint front corner of Lots 321 and 320; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 0-08 W. 147 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 319 N. 89-52 E. 16.6 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Phoenix Avenue; thence with the West line of said Avenue S. 24-31 E. 136.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along a curved course the chord of which is S. 32-12 W. 27.4 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Pacific Avenue; thence along the North side of Pacific Avenue S. 89-52 W. 57.3 feet to point of beginning.
