(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:



NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, about three and one-half miles South of Greer, S.C. on the Eastern side of the surface-treated road leading from Greer, S.C. to Pelham, S.C., and having the following metes and bounds, townit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of the Greer-Pelham Road, joint corner of lands of Willie Mayfield and J. R. Greene, and running thence in an Easterly direction with the dividing line between said Mayfield and Greene, 288 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Northerly direction, 358 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Westerly direction, 262 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern edge of said road; thence in a Southerly direction with the Eastern edge of said road, 259 feet to the beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor herein by J. R. Greene by deed dated April 7, 1945, recorded in Volume 283 at Page 218.
