ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, O'Noal Township, about one mile west f from Jackson Grove Methosid Church, lying on the south side of the McElhaney Road, being bounded on the north by the said road, on the east by lands of Clardy Langford, on the mouth by lands of W. E. Black Estate and on the west by lot of W. Edward Black, and being the same lot of la land conveyed to me by deed from W. Edward Black January 30th 1951, and recorded in the office of the R. M.
