granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of . Greenville. Bates. Township, containing 23-1/2 acres, more or less, adjoining lands of E. E. Rich, Rachel Duncan and others, being the northern portion of a tract of land containing 118-1/2 acres, more or less, shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book B, at page 113, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING on a stone (pine gone), thence running N. 32 3/4 W. 11.80 chains to a stone OM; thence S. 55-1/4 W. 18.00 chains to the center of Keelers Mill Road; thence S. 27 E. with said road 7.00 chains to a bend; thence S. 7 E. 6.00 chains to a bend; thence S. 34 E. .78 chains to iron pin at underpass; thence N. 50 E. 21.00 chains to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same tract of land conveyed to us by E. E. Rich by his deed dated May 14, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 347, at page 322."
