WHEREAS I, **Nell G. Von Hollen**, am
well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of **Five Thousand and No/100 (\$5,000.00)** - - - - -
Dollars, in and by **me** certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said **Nell G. Von Hollen**,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

S. C. National Bank, its Successors and Assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South
Carolina, on branch waters of Reedy River, and being known and designated
as part-of-tract **No. 8** on plat of property of **S. C. Pinson**, and having
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Crestwood Drive
(formerly designated as road leading by Dreamland Lake to Paris Moun-
tain), 112 feet from corner of tract No. 7, and running thence along the
center of said drive S. 32 W. 532 feet to corner; thence S. 40-25 E.
640.5 feet to corner on edge of Duke Power Company right-of-way; thence
with edge of said right-of-way S. 40-25 W. 150 feet to corner in line
of said tract No. 8; thence S. 40-00 E. 538.7 feet to iron pin in
branch; thence N. 32 E. 794 feet to iron pin, rear corner of tract No.
7; thence along line of tract No. 7, N. 40 W. 340 feet, more or less,
