5. This agreement is conditioned upon approval of the duly authorized representative of the Veterans' Administration and is not to become effective until so approved.

6. This agreement, when approved by the Veterans! Administration as above profided, shall bind jointly and severally the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Fidelity and of the Obligor respectively.
