WHEREAS I, Anabel C. Riggins, of Greenville County, am well and truly indebted to W. A. Hammond

in the full and just sum of Twenty-Five Hundred, Fifty and No/100 - - - - - (\$2550.00 ) Dollars. in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable as follows: in monthly instalments of Forty-Two and No/100 - (\$42.00) Dollars each, beginning on the 7th day of August, 1951 and continuing on the 7th day of each and every succeeding calendar month thereafter until the principal debt has been paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to the principal balance remaining due from month to month

with interest from date at the rate of six per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Anabel C. Riggins

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. A. Hammond, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 18, Section B, as shown on plat of the property of H. H. Willis made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November, 1939 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at page 150, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Clemson Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 19, and running thence along the line of that lot, N. 53-50 W. 271.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 36-15 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 17; thence along the line of that lot, S. 53-50 E. 278.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the northwest side of Clemson Avenue; thence along the northwest side of said Clemson Avenue, S. 40-30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. A. Hammond by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded.

This is a second and junior mortgage, being junior to the lien of the First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, his Heirs and Assigns, from and against me, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
