SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Jean M. Blenis

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Four Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and No-100---- (\$4,250.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of Thirty-Six and No/100----- (\$ 36.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Jean M. Blenis

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said Jean M. Blenis in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, South Carolina, being designated as Lots Nos. 72 and 73, and the eastern 10-ft. of Lot. No. 71, of a sub-division of the Theron Earle property known as 'Oaklawn' as shown by plat made by Fitzpatrick-Terry Company, dated May 6, 1920, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office in plat book 'E', page 273. The above mentioned property has a total frontage of 60 feet on the north side of Locust Avenue, with a depth of 123 feet, more or less. This is the same property conveyed to me by Oren F. Beaty by deed dated September 26, 1950, recorded in deed book 422, page 66, and being designated as Lot No. 24, block 4, page 175 of the County Block Book.
