C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Seven Thousand and No/100----

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the Eastern side of Brookside Avenue (formerly Brookside Way) being shown as lots Nos. 21 and 22, on plat of Overbrook Land Company Tract No. 1, recorded in Plat Book J at Page 81, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Brookside Avenue, at joint front corner of lots Nos. 20 and 21, and running thence with line of lot No. 20, N. 45-3Q E. 180 feet to iron pin; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the rear line of lots Nos. 21 and 22, 122.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-11 W. 180 feet to an iron pin on Brookside Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Brookside Avenue, 120 feet to the point of beginning."
