BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeast corner of the intersection of Furman Hall Road with an unnamed road, and running thence along the northeast side of said unnamed road, S. 75 E. 130 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 1; thence along the line of that lot, N. 28-25 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of that lot, N. 75 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the southeast side of Furman Hall Road; thence along the line of said Furman Hall Road, S. 28-25 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lots are the same as conveyed to me by W. D. McBrayer by deed dated February 18, 1937 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 192, at page 110.
