full and just sum of Six Thousand, Six Hundred and No/100 (\$6,600.00
Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed
thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, on the eastern side of Wildwood Road, being known and designa as Lot No. 30 on plat of Woodland Hills recorded in Plat Book Y, at page 60 and described as follows:
