First day of November , 195 3 and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Grove Township, on the Georgia Road, School District No. 110, Old No. 4 H, Greenville County, South Carolina, and containing Forty One (41) acres, more or less, according to a survey and plat made for C.E.Garrison under date of December 3, 1934, by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, which said plat is recorded in the office of the R. M.C., Greenville County, in Plat Book O, Page 77. Said tract of land is bounded by lands new or formerly owned by E. B. Martin, Jr., on the North and across the Georgia Road from the property in question, C.S. Poore on the East with his lands lying across a public road from the lands in question, by J. R.Ridgeway on the South, and R. L. Garrison on the west.
