All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Northwest side of Perry Road, and being known and designated as Lot 24 of the Property of Hext M. Perry, Trustee, as shown on plat thereof made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, February 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "R", at page 102, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Perry Road at the edge of a 5-foot strip reserved for sidewalk, at the corner of Lot 23, which point is 240 feet Southwest of the intersection of Dykeson Avenue and running thence along the North side of said 5-foot strip, S. 43 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 25; thence along the line of that lot, N. 47 W. 124 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 36-22 E. 60.15 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 23; thence along the line of said lot, S. 47 E. 131 feet to the beginning corner.
