WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Six Thousand and No/100- - - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 6000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 9 of White Oak Subdivison of Northside Development Company as shown on a plat prepared by John D. Pellett, Jr. in August 1946, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 121, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Sewanee Street and White Oak Way (Highway # 291) and running thence with the right-of-way line of Highway # 291, N. 45-23 W. 128.3 feet to a stake, common corner of lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence with the Eastern line of lot No. 8, S. 44-37 W. 130 feet to a stake, common corner of lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence with the line of lot No. 10, S. 63-59 E. 141.5 feet to a stake on the West side of Sewanee Street; thence with the West side of Sewanee Street, N. 33-58 E. 93.6 feet to the point of beginning."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Loyall H. Smith by deed recorded in Volume 452 at Page 383.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
