to iron pin; themee S. 39-11 W. 120 feet to iron pin; thence N. 50-49 W. 217.5 feet to corner in center of the Georgia Road at beginning and now being vacant but to have constructed there on a residence for the use of the Pastor of the said Church.

This obligation is made by virtue of the authority of a Resolution of the congregation of the Standing Springs Baptist Church passed on June 7, 1953.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
