TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Roy L. Haynes, Jr., and Francis G. Souther (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eleven Thousand and No/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$11,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

* All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the southeastern side of Pitts Street as shown on a plat of the property of Talmer Cordell made by Dalton & Neves in April, 1951, recorded in Plat Book Aa, Page 33, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Pitts Street which pin is 209.7 feet northeast from the intersection of Pitts Street and Hampton Circle at the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19 and running thence with joint line of said lots S. 47-00 E. 205 feet to an iron pin in the northwest side of Hampton Circle; thence with said Circle N. 43-00 E. 85 feet to an iron pin rear corner of Lot 17; thence with line of said lot N. 47-00 W. 205 feet to an iron pin in the southeast side of Pitts street; thence with said street S. 43-00 W. 85 feet to the point of beginning."

Being the same premises conveyed to mortgagors by W. B. Shockley, et al, by deed recorded in Volume 476 at Page 535.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
