We, Raymond Evans and Ruth R. Evans

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Forty-Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100-----DOLLARS (\$ 4950.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Four & One-Half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as lot #117, of Glenn Grove Park as shown by a subdivision and plat of same made by R. E. Dalton, Eng., in May 1924, said plat being of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 233, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Monticello Avenue at the corner of lot # 116; and running thence along the line of lot # 116, S. 27-18 W. 168 feet; thence S. 41-19 E. 53.8 feet to corner of lot # 118; thence along the line last mentioned, N. 27-18 E. 137.9 feet to an iron pin in line of Monticello Avenue; thence along the line of said Evenue, N. 62-42 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
