TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Edward M. Hempley and Janet B. Hempley,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even-date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$ 7,500.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, within the limits of the City of Greer, located on the northern side of VanDeventer Drive or Street, known and designated as Lot No. 19 on a plat of property made for James K. Cornwell by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July 3, 1949, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake, joint corner Lots Nos. 18 and 19 on said plat on the northern side of said street, and runs thence with the common line of said lots N. 0.42 E. 251 feet to a stake on line of Mrs. J.C. Cunningham property; thence with her line S. 78.54 E. 76.2 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 20; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 S. 0.42 W. 237.4 feet to a stake on said street; thence with the street N. 69.12 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of that lot of land conveyed to the mortgagors in two deeds, to wit: Deed from Mary E. Cornwell dated January 30, 1954, recorded in Deed Book 493, at page 157, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and deed from E. Inman, Master, dated January 29, recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 493, at page 147.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
