To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, James W. Poole and Maggie Bell Locke Clark Poole, formerly Maggie Bell Locke Clark

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Four Thousand, One Hundred and No/100 - - - - -

(\$4,100.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of Forty-One and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 41.00)

Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, known as a part of the land conveyed to C. E. Clark, by deed from The Farmers Bank of Traveler's Rest, better known as a part of the Frank Miller place, adjoining lands of C. E. Clark and the Renfrew Bleachery Company land, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING on an iron pin in New Road, thence running with said road, N. 4-1/2 E. 3.86 chains to a bridge on branch; thence with branch, S. 60 W. 2.80 chains to a bend; thence N. 82 W. 1.00 chain to a poplar tree on branch x 3 n.m.; thence S. 4-1/2 W. 2.40 chains to an iron pin n. m.; thence S. 85-1/2 E. 3.33 chains to the beginning corner, and containing one acre, more or less, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.

"The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagor, Maggie Bell Locke Clark Poole, under the name of Maggie Bell Locke Clark by W. L. Clark by deed dated August 17, 1951 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 441, at page 173, the said Maggie Bell Locke Clark Poole having conveyed an undivided one-half interest in said property to the mortgagor, James W. Poole, by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
