SEND GREETING:

Whereas, we, the said Willard B. Mills, Robert C. Brownlee, Jr., Harold P. Jackson and W. R. DeLoache in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to The South Carolina National Bank of Greenville, S. C.

in the full and just sum of Twenty-five Thousand and no/100th (\$25,000.00) Dollars, to be paid six (6) months from date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be computed and paid at maturity
