NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as a portion of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 of the property of Sumlar Hall in a section known as Nicholtown as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Fickell and Pickell, Eng., on September 18, 1953, said lots being a portion of Tract No. 5 of the property of the estate of James Hall as shown on other thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in First Book C at page 89, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the property of D. U. Mauldin according to a plat thereof prepared by C. C. Jones, C.E., August 4, 1954, and having, according to the Jones Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of half Street, joint front corners of Lots 2 and 3 and running themse with the joint line of said lots, N. 22-38 W. 125.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 67-22 N. 67 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of River Street; thence with said Street, S. 26-31 E. 126 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of River Street and Hall Street; thence with Hall Street N. 67-22 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the same property conveyed to me by Sumlar Hall by deed dated August 7, 1954 and recorded in the 3. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 505, page 453.

This also includes the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty."

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
