MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **Arthur B. Gilbert** (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **Bank of Travelers Rest**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

Seven hundred fifty DOLLARS (\$ 750.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$50.00 on the 11th day of November, 1954 and a like payment on the 11th day of each following month until paid in full. Interest to be paid semi-annually in advance.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, being a part of the land conveyed to Clarence Lee Ballew and Ethel S. Ballew by deed of James H. and Annie H. Ballew on April 6, 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Book 345 at Page 425, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING in center of bridge on county road over creek and running thence S. 62 W. 50 feet to bend in road; thence S. 76 W. 200 feet to bend in road; thence S. 72 W. 88 feet to forks of road; thence with Ballew Road N. 10 E. 275 feet to iron pin in creek; thence with creek as line in a southeastern direction 325 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1 acre, more or less.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Clarence Lee Ballew, et al, by deed recorded in Deed Book 430 at Page 73.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
