C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twelve Hundred and No/100- - - -

DOLLARS (\$1200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, situate in Ward I of the City of Greenville, county and state aforesaid, fronting 55 feet on Wilton Street and bounded on the North by lots Nos. 2, 3 and 4 as shown on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 89, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a corner of lands now or formerly owned by Wells and Westfield, running thence in an Easterly direction along said rear lines of the said Westfield property 241 feet to a stone on Wilton Street; thence in a Southerly direction with Wilton Street, 55 feet to a stone on said street; thence in a Westerly direction 236 feet to a point on a lot now or formerly belonging to Wells; thence in a Northerly direction 55 feet to the beginning corner."
