until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina containing 2.25 acres, more or less, and being known as Tract #1 of the property of Grace Campbell Martin as plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, September, 1912, and better particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in middle of Piedmont-Pessie road, then along W. P. Nashitt line; thence S. 48-30 E. 500 feet to point in middle of said road; thence N. 20-30 E. 24.7 feet to stake beside said road; thence in same direction 667 feet to stake on J. A. Fledley line; thence S. 89-15 W. 537 feet to iron pin in W. O. stump; thence S. 11-05 W. 279 feet along W. P. Nashitt line to point of beginning.
