KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other considerations ---(\$-----)-Dollars, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release from the lien of that certain security instrument from -----

to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, securing the payment of the principal sum of Thirty six thousand five hundred -----(\$36,500.00) Dollars, dated the 22 day of December 19 54, and recorded in the public records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Volume Book 627, at page 223, the following described property, to-wit:

All that parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the east side of a county road in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to a survey made by C. O. Middle, March, 1954, recorded in the S. E. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Flat Book 2, Page 122, the following metes and bounds to wit: BEGINNING at a point in the center of Rocky Creek under the bridge of the county road crossing said creek; and at corner of property now or formerly of E. M. Bishop and running thence along said county road, the following courses and distances: North 12 degrees East, 180 feet; North 0 degrees 50 minutes West, 377 feet; North 5 degrees 10 minutes West, 228 feet; North 17 degrees 00 minutes, 525 feet; North 12 degrees 10 minutes West, 470 feet, to the center of the intersection of said county road and another county road; thence continuing with the said county road, North 21 degrees 55 minutes East, 743.7 feet to an iron pin on the east side of said county road; thence continuing with said county road, North 25 degrees 15 minutes West, 719.4 feet to an iron pin in said road at corner of property now or formerly of Henry McIntire; thence along the said McIntire line, North 25 degrees 46 minutes East, 302.1 feet to an iron pin; thence still with McIntire line, South 83 degrees 55 minutes East, 828.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of property of Moore, North 54 degrees 51 minutes East, 358 feet to an iron pin in line of property of T. C. Cleveland; thence along said Cleveland line, South 20 degrees 15 minutes East, 689 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Cleveland line and line of property of Rolling Green Real Estate Company, South 32 degrees 34 minutes East, 1182 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with line of property of Rolling Green Real Estate Company, South 47 degrees 09 minutes East, 807 feet to a point in the center of Rocky Creek; thence down the center of Rocky Creek, the traverse line being as follows: North 58 degrees 37 minutes East, 391.5 feet; North 68 degrees 49 minutes East, 104.2 feet; South 75 degrees 15 minutes East, 95 feet, to a point in the center of Rocky Creek; thence leaving said Rocky Creek and running South 25 degrees 50 minutes East, 565.1 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly of Larthum Durham; thence with said Durham line, South 77 degrees 30 minutes West, 788.1 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Durham line, South 0 degrees 30 minutes West, 279.3 feet to corner of property now or formerly of I. A. Brockman; thence with said Brockman line, South 65 degrees 45 minutes West, 536 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Brockman line, North 42 degrees 30 minutes West, 410 feet to a point in center of Rocky Creek; thence up the center of Rocky Creek, the traverse lines being as follows: South 80 degrees 12 minutes West, 77.5 feet; North 71 degrees 37 minutes West, 67.3 feet; North 66 degrees 48 minutes West, 221.4 feet; North 78 degrees 45 minutes West,
