ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE TO UNITED STATES AS TRUSTEES BOOK 638 PAGE 111

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF ATLANTA, whose post office address is ATLANTA 2, GEORGIA, herein called "Assignor", the owner and holder of a certain mortgage dated February 24, 1955, made by John O. Gresham, Jr. and Nell M. Gresham, his wife, as Mortgagors, to The First National Bank of Atlanta as Mortgagee, and recorded in Real Estate Mortgage Book 628, at Page(s) 211, (Book Title and No.)

in the Office of the R. M. C. of Greenville, State of South Carolina, for value received, does hereby assign, transfer, convey and set over said mortgage, together with all right, title and interest of the Assignor in the property described therein, unto the United States of America, acting through the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration, herein called the "Government," as Trustee, whose post office address is Washington 25, D. C., to have and to hold the same unto the Government in trust for the use and benefit of ROBERT F. GODDARD, C/O CONTINENTAL ILLINOIS NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO "T" CHICAGO 90, ILLINOIS, whose post office address is 231 SO. LA SALLE STREET, CHICAGO 90, ILLINOIS, as the holder of the note or bond described in said mortgage, and for the use and benefit of any subsequent holder of said note or bond. The Government is hereby given full power to manage the trust property hereby assigned and to have, use and enforce all rights, powers and authority of the mortgagee under said mortgage, including but not limited to the subordination, assignment, release, satisfaction or discharge of said mortgage, in whole or in part; provided that the trust hereby created shall not be revocable by the Assignor or any present or subsequent holder of said note or bond, and shall be subject to the provisions of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act (7 U.S.C. 1000 et seq.), as now or hereafter amended or supplemented; provided further that neither the Assignor nor any present or subsequent holder of said note or bond shall be liable for compensation to the Government for management of the trust property or for any expenses incurred in connection therewith.
