MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, James W. Jarrell and Doris Mae Jarrell, of Greenville County,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Two Thousand and No/100 - - -

(\$ 2,000,00 ) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Circle Street (formerly Brookside Avenue) in the City of Greenville, and being a portion of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 as shown on plat of Hillside Heights made by R. E. Dalton in September, 1921, and recorded in Plat Book "F" at page 100 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the western side of Circle Street, corner of property now or formerly owned by R. R. Ray, and running thence with the line of said property, S. 45-11 W. 98.75 feet to a stake; thence S. 77-00 W. 49.6 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 14; thence with the line of said lot and continuing with the line of Lot No. 13, S. 27-42 E. 55 feet to a stake; thence N. 55-30 E. 159 feet to a stake on Circle Street; thence with the western side of Circle Street, N. 44-19 W. 55 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by John L. Drake by deed dated September 12th, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 419, page 31."
