COUNTY OF Greenville To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I, Horace L. Mauldin, of Greenville County, SEND GREETINGS: WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-VILLE, in the full and just sum of Five Thousand, Four Hundred and No/100 - - - - -

) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note, (the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of Fifty-Four and No/100 -

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southern side of Marchant Street near Monaghan Mills, and known and designated as Lot 8 as shown on a plat entitled "Monaghan Subdivision, Greenville, S. C." made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C., August 9, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 86 and 87, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Marchant Street at the joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8 and running thence with the Southern side of Marchant Street, N. 74-58 E., 90 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence with the common line of said two lots, S. 10-15 E., 280.2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 2; thence with the line of Lot 2, S. 74-13 W., 51 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence with the common lines of said two lots, N. 18-13 W., 282.3 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. by its deed dated July 15, 1955, not yet recorded."
