Heights made by W. D. Dalton, Engineer, dated June 1, 1911 and recorded  
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 204,  
and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Buist Avenue, which  
iron pin is situate 337.2 feet east of the intersection of Buist Avenue
