NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby-acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, W.C.

Henson and his heirs and assigns forever:

All of those parcels or lots of land in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greer and northeast therefrom, lying on the North side of the U.S. Dual Lane No. 29 and on the West side of Line Street Extension, known and designated as Lots Nos. 14, 15, 16, 22 and 23 on a plat of property made for Nancy W. Finley and Ellen W. Crain by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 24, 1941, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the North edge of the right-of-way of said U.S. Dual Lane Highway No. 29 (Super Highway), and runs thence along the North edge of the right-of-way S. 85.00 E. 225 feet to an iron pin on the West edge of Line Street Extension; thence with the West edge of said street N. 5.00 E. 274 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 69.39 E. 11.3 feet to an iron pin, corner with land formerly owned by Emma K. Cannon; thence with the Cannon line(now center of Line Street Extension) N. 1.26 E. 335.4 feet to an iron pin in said street and in line with the South edge of Wilson Avenue; thence with the South edge of Wilson Avenue S. 81.06 W. 244 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10.00 E. 367.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5.00 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of that property conveyed to the late Sam G. Bruce by I.H. Gibson and Jean MdDill Gibson by deed dated August 1, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 460, at page 378.

Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake or stone on the Fred Clark Estate line, the southwestern corner of the tract herein conveyed and runs thence with the Clark line as follows: N. 59 E. 256.5 feet to a stone, N. 88.15 E. 445.6 feet to an iron pin or stone, and N. 60.15 E. 334 feet to a point in the center of State Highway No. 14(stake back on line and on bank of highway); thence with said highway (designated as Mosteller Road on said plat) N. 31.21 W. 355 feet to a turn; thence N. 28.30 W. along said highway 215.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 72.15 W. 382 feet to a stake in the Dantzler Ballenger Road; thence along said road the following courses & distances: S. 23.25 W. 110 feet, S. 32.45 W
