Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina., situate, lying and being in the new city limits of the City of Greer, South Carolina, lying on the southern side of Johnson Avenue and on the northern side of Maple Creek, being shown and designated as Lot No. 28 on plat of property of G.B. & A. B. Johnson, said plat prepared by J. H. Atkins, Surveyor, March 25-27, 1946, plus a 15 foot strip along the eastern line which was originally reserved for one-half of a road or street, the other half or 15 feet was to have been given by extra 15 feet, and being the same lot that was conveyed to Carlisle M.
