SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said H. N. Hammond, Mrs. Ollie Farnsworth
in and by my certain promissory R. M. C.
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Bank of Simpsonville
in the full and just sum of Five Hundred and No/100 --
, to be paid six months after date

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, in
advance until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and
being in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina,
containing 36 acres, and formerly known as the "J. H. Cox lands,"
bounded by lands now or formerly of J. H. Baldwin and W. F. Garrett,
on the north Mrs. Q. Alverson estate on the east, Alton Chandler
on the south, and E. P. Smith on the west, as is fully represented
on a plat made by W. J. Riddle (for J. H. Cox), on June 21, 1933,
and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County,
