All that lot of land lying on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Old Augusta Road with DeCyley Avenue and being shown as Lot 19 on a plat of Augusta Road Ranches prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated April, 1941 and recorded in Plat Book M at page 47, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Old Augusta Road, the front corner of lot 20, running thence with the line of said lot, S. 89-47 W. 198.3 feet to an iron pin on the East side of a 15 foot alley; thence with the East side of said alley, N. 00-13 W. 50 feet to an iron pin on the South side of DeOyley Avenue; thence with the South side of said Avenue, N. 89-47 E. 178.4 feet to an iron pin near the intersection of DeOyley Avenue with old Augusta Road; thence with the curve of said intersection, the chord of which is S. 42-36 E. 33.7 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Old AugustaRoad; thence with the West side of said road, S. 5-00 W. 25.2 feet to the beginning.
