All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southwest side of Welcome Road, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot # 3 on a plat of the O. T. White Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book O at Page 147, being more particularly described according to a plat of the property of Hubert E. Thomas prepared by J. C. Hill Dated February 29, 1959, as follows:
