TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Thomas B. Waters,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Three Thousand -----

DOLLARS (\$ 3,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six & one-half (6½%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, on the north side of the Woodruff Road near Five Forks, containing 18 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Lindsey Forrester, Norman Waters, W.R. Cox, Charles Perry and Kendrick, and being the remaining portion of Tract No. 6 of the L.L. Green Estate, and the same conveyed to Thomas B. Waters by deed of Norman McKinley Waters recorded in Deed Book 304, page 202, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, LESS, therefrom, several lots which have been conveyed to or contracted to other parties, as shown by recorded deeds and a recorded plat.

The said eighteen acres, more or less, is the tract upon which the home of the said Thomas B. Waters is located.
