

That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and turther sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 100 as shown on a plat of Sections 1 and 2, Western Hills, prepared by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, dated August, 1959, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ at pages 98 and 99, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Tuscon Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 99 and 100, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 99 S. 16-43 E. 174.1 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 76; thence with the rear lines of Lots Nos. 76 and 75 S. 73-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 73, 75 and 100; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 73 and 72 N. 16-43 W. 173.8 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Tuscon Drive; thence with the Southern side of Tuscon Drive; thence with the Southern side of Tuscon Drive N. 73-17 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
