

NO. 3: The northwest portion of the rear of Lot 58 as shown on plat of Cagle Park Company recorded in Plat Book C at pages 237 and 238, together with the eastern one-half of what was formerly shown on said plat as a 15-foot alley and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of McKay Street, at corner of property now or formerly owned by Stewart, and running thence with line of said property in a southerly direction 109 feet to a stake in line of property now or formerly owned by Burbage; thence with the line of said property in a Westernly direction 30.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4-52 W. 115.4 feet to a stake on the said McKay Street; thence with the Southern side of McKay Street, N. 89-15 E. 33.5 feet to the beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Deed Book A05 at Page 158.
