To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Ralph L. Williams and Elizabeth P. Williams

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Ralph L. Williams and Elizabeth P. Williams

in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of One thousand and no/100 - - - - - (\$1,000.00) Dollars,

with interest from the date hereof at the rate of seven per cent ( 7 %) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

Fifteen and 83/100 - - - - - (\$ 15.83) Dollars

due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection; to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the said Ralph L. Williams and Elizabeth P. Williams in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the Langley Road and running thence with the Langley line No. 1, 12 W. 360 feet, to an iron pin on said line; thence S. 70.30 W. 156 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9.52 E. 350 feet to an iron pin in the center of above said road; thence with the center of said road N. 68.40 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, containing one acre.

The above described land is a portion of the same land willed to Guy Langley by J. M. Langley, and is on the northwest side of the above said road joined by land of Guy Langley on the north and west, and on the east by Williams.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to us by Guy Langley by Deed dated June 12, 1954, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

ALSO: That lot located near Locust Hill Baptist Church, lying on the north side of the Langley Road, being shown on a plat of property made for Ralph L. and Elizabeth Williams by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, dated February 27, 1962, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a nail in the center of the Langley Road, joint corner with grantees' other property (iron pin on north bank of road), and runs thence with grantees' other property, N. 10-15 W. 315 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50 W. 74.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-15 E. 325 feet to a nail in the center of said road (iron pin on north bank thereof); thence along the center of said road, N. 68-25 E. 65.7 feet to the beginning, containing 50/100 acres, more or less.

This is a part of the real estate devised to Virginia Brookshire Langley, Ruth Langley Moon, and Mary Langley Jones by the late Lawrence Guy Langley, whose will is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 640, page 19.
