

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor (s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Third Thousand and no/100 (30,000.00)

Dollars (or for future ddvances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

extended, will be due and payable 20 years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centium attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms by said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Lots Nos. 6 and 7 according to a plat of the property of Talmer Cordell prepared by Dalton and Neves, April 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, at Page 33, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on the southern side of Super Highway No. 29 at corner of Lot No. 5 on said highway, 511.8 feet eastward from the intersection of Hampton Circle with Super Highway No. 29, and running thence with the southern side of said Super Highway, N. 43 E. 200 feet to pin at corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8, S. 47 E. 300 feet to the northern side of Pitts Street; thence with the northern side of Pitts Street, S. 43 W. 200 feet to the rear corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of Lot No. 5, N. 47 W. 300 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to J. W. Pitts and Dorothy M. Pitts by Local Home Builders, Inc., by its deed dated May 5, 1951 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 438, at Page 101, the said J. W. Pitts having conveyed his undivided one-half interest to the mortgagor, Dorothy M. Pitts, by deed dated January 4, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 515, at Page 346.
