NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indubted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Butler Avenue near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 12 as shown on a plat prepared by Madison H. Woodward, dated May, 1946, entitled "Cole Acres, Property of W.E. McCain", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P at page 73, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Butler Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 11 S. 14-20 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 27 S. 78-00 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence with the line of Lot No. 13 N. 14-20 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Butler Avenue; thence with the Southern side of Butler Avenue N. 78-00 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
