Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville,

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon on Anchorage Drive in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Caroline, being the greater portion of Lot No. 15 and a small triangular portion of Lot No. 12, which lots are shown on plat of Davis Property in Eastover recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "AA" at page 125; and said property being more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Anchorage Drive, which iron pin is 278 feet from the intersection of Haviland Avenue and Anchorage Drive, and running thence N. 60-50 E. 134.6 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of Lot No. 7, S. 41-29 E. 67.2 feet to iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 14; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 15 and 14, S. 55-17 W. 155.9 feet to iron pin on Anchorage Drive; thence along Anchorage Drive, N. 26-15 W., 82 feet to the beginning corner.
