NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oaklawn, coataing five acres more or less, and having the following courses and distances to wit.

"Beginning at iron pin center of Georgia Road thence S-39-50E 796 Feet to iron pin corner T. M. Fennell Line thence N-35-00-E 213 Feet to iron pin corner S. H. Pakton line thence with line of S. H. Paxton S-44-15-E 924 feet to iron pin center Georgia Road thence S-64-00-W 286 feet to point of Origin."

This being that piece of land conveyed to me by T. N. Fennell by deed dated March 28, 1946, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in book 293, at page 74.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
