"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Towhsnip, near the city of Simpsonville, S. C., being on the north side of Richardson Street and having, according to a plat of the estate of Mrs. Bessie H. Richardson prepared by C. O. Riddle, January, 1960, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book TT at page 129, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
