"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, Sate of South Carolina, on the northern side of Woodmont Lane and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 of Woodfields as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "S", at page 7 and having, according to said plat the following meets and bounds to-wit:
