CLOVERLEAF LATERAL

One 10-inch transmission sales lateral, approximately 0.09 miles in length, beginning at mile post 1802.79 on line "A", and continuing in a southeasterly direction to the header assembly at the Cloverleaf M&B Station, all in Woodbridge Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. Included in this transmission sales lateral are a 6-inch valve and blow-off assembly at the intersection with line "A", a 10-inch valve at mile post 0.04, and a valve assembly in the inlet and outlet heater lines at mile post 0.04.

TEXASCO-EAGLE POINT LATERAL

One 6-inch transmission sales lateral, approximately 0.02 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 14.46 on the 12-inch Woodbury Lateral and continuing in a southerly direction to the header in the Texasco-Eagle Point M&B Station, all in West Deptford Township, Gloucester County, New Jersey. Included in this transmission sales lateral are a lateral valve and check valve at the take-off, and a lateral valve and heater assembly at mile post 0.01.
