ARTICLE XIII

AMENDMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENT

Requiring Consent of Bondholders. The County and the Trustee shall without the consent of or notice to the Bondholders consent to any amendment, change or modification of the Lease Agreement as may be required (i) by the provisions of the Lease Agreement and this Indenture, (ii) for the purpose of curing any ambiguity or formal defect or omission, (iii) in connection with the land and interests in land described in Exhibit A to the Lease Agreement so as to identify more precisely the same or substitute or add additional land or interests in land, or (iv) in connection with any other change therein which, in the judgment of the Trustee, is not to the prejudice of the Trustee or the holders of the Bonds.

Requiring Consent of Bondholders. Except for the amendments, changes or modifications as provided in Section 1301 hereof, neither the County nor the Trustee shall consent to any other amendment, change or modification of the Lease Agreement without publication of notice and the written approval or consent of the holders of not less than two-thirds in aggregate principal amount of the Bonds at the time outstanding given and procured as in Section 1202 provided.
